Next Two Months Worst on Highway
Oregon drivers were reminded today that the next two months offer one of the most dangerous times of the year on streets and highways.

The Department of Motor Vehicles cautioned that November and December rank as the highest accident-producing months of the year. Last year, 5,806 traffic accidents occurred in December and 5,577 were reported in November.

The average December brings 6,000 traffic accidents, while November generally sees about 5,500 crashes reported.

Generally, the period is thought to produce more accidents than other times of the year, because of favorable weather conditions, heavy urban traffic associated with holiday shopping and longer hours of darkness. The increase incidence of drinking and driving especially during December, also contributes to the record.

The department urges people to adjust their driving to meet winter conditions, and to practice all the rules of safe driving.
