## Telephone Company Pays \$17,364 Taxes

Pacific Northwest Bell joined other businesses and residents of Morrow County in paying 1962-63 property taxes on Thursday (Nov. 15).

Dale Slusher, manager for the company, said a check for \$17,364.86 had been sent to the courthouse. The net amount after discount was one of the largest payments in the county this year.

"We certainly recognize that it is actually our customers who foot the tax bill," Slusher said.

"Even though the company sends in the tax check, 'only people pay taxes.'"

Throughout the state on Thursday, Pacific Northwest Bell paid taxes totaling \$5.4 million, an increase of some 7.8 per cent over last year.
