ORDINANCE NO. 42-1964 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN OFFICE TO BE KNOWN AS THE BOARDMAN RELOCATION OFFICE AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE OFFICER THEREOF TO BE KNOWN AS THE BOARDMAN RELOCATION ADMINISTRATOR; AND DEFINING THE DUTIES OF SAID OFFICER
 The people of the City of Boardman do ordain as follows: Section 1. **Establishment of Office.** The office of Boardman Relocation Office is hereby established. The officer in charge of said office shall be known as the Boardman Relocation Administrator. Section 2. **Duties.** It shall be the duty of the Boardman Administrator to be in charge and administer all the relocation activities that are convenient or made necessary by the disturbance and relocation as a result of the John Day Dam project. That it shall be the duty of the Boardman Relocation Administrator to administer the relocation activities under the direction of the City government pursuant to the charter and ordinances of the City of Boardman, and the contracts to be entered into between the City of Boardman and the United States of America providing for certain relocation activities. The Boardman Relocation Administrator shall appoint such additional assistants as he may from time to time require. Such appointments being subject to confirmation by the City Council. Section 3. **Appointment.** The Boardman Relocation Administrator shall be appointed by the council pursuant to Article 5, Section 1 of the Boardman Charter. Section 4. **Salaries.** The compensation for the services of the Boardman Relocation Administrator shall be the amount fixed by the council from time to time and shall be designated in the minutes of the council. Other salaries for the employees of the Boardman Relocation Office shall be set by the council in the same manner. Section 5. **Vacancies in Office.** The office of Boardman Relocation Administrator shall be deemed vacant as provided for vacancies in office, Article 2, Section 8 and 9, of the Boardman City Charter. Section 6. **Annual Report.** The Boardman Relocation Administrator shall make an annual report to the city council during the month of January following each calendar year, which report shall contain a financial statement of the year's activities and a statement of recommendation and suggestions for the coming year's finances and activities. Section 7. **Oath of Office.** That prior to taking office the Boardman Relocation Administrator shall take an oath of office and before assuming the duties shall be bonded in the amount to be determined by the council.
