**Research Reports Planned at OSU Beef Cattle Day**

One of the world's foremost authorities on beef cattle breeding, Dr. Jan C. Bonsma of South Africa, will be a featured speaker at the 7th annual Oregon State University Beef Cattle Day May 28, according to A. T. Ralston, field day chairman.

Bonsma will talk about fertility in beef cattle, and present a demonstration of his much-discussed methods for evaluating fertility of beef heifers. The program also will include talks on current research by members of the OSU Animal Science department.

Bill Southworth, assistant director of the state Department of Agriculture, will preside over the morning session. Discussion topics will include a review of research by J. C. Miller, department head; factors affecting feed efficiency in beef cattle, John Landers; protein levels in finishing rations, Walter Kenrick; pasture research, Tom Bedell; and use of fat in beef cattle rations, David Church.

The afternoon session will be presided over by Bill Marshall, Klamath Falls, president of the Oregon Cattleman's Association. It will feature a talk on public relations by Joe Bianco, Oregonian agricultural editor, Portland, and cross-breeding within breeds, Ralph Bogart, range seeding, Tom Bunch; controlled estrus, Ray Novotny; hormonal castration, Ralston; and discussion of disease problems by Dean Frischknecht and Dr. Dean Smith.

Beef Cattle Day is sponsored by the OSU Agricultural Experiment Station in cooperation with the Western Oregon Livestock Association and the Oregon Cattleman's Association. The annual event provides an opportunity for beef cattle producers to meet with research workers and discuss mutual problems as well as current research in the field.
