ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals for the construction of a municipal building and water supply system for the new townsite at Boardman, Oregon, addressed to the Mayor and City Council, Boardman, Oregon, will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Boardman, Oregon, until 2:00 p.m., Pacific Daylight Time, on the 23rd day of September, 1965, and then will be publicly opened and read.

The work contemplated is divided into two schedules as follows:
Schedule A. Municipal Building and Site Improvements. The work contemplated consists of the construction of a one-story municipal building, approximately 51'x62' for the City offices, fire station, and other facilities. The building is to be constructed with concrete foundation and floor, concrete block walls and block and frame partitions, frame roof with built-up roofing over wood decking, and overhead doors at fire station. The work includes painting, plumbing, heating, electrical work, paving, grading and seeding as required for a complete structure.

Schedule C. Water Supply System. The work contemplated consists of furnishing and installing a 500 gpm deep well vertical turbine pump, complete with a motor for exterior installation, a hydroponematic tank 7 feet in diameter by 25 feet long (approximate capacity 5,600 gallons), complete with float controls, all piping and appurtenances, electrical power system, and related work for a complete operable water system.

Plans and Specifications may be examined in the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Boardman, Oregon, or at the office of Cornell, Howland, Hayes & Merryfield, Engineers and Planners, 1600 Western Avenue, Corvallis, Oregon, or 830 Logan Building, 500 Union Street, Seattle, Washington. A copy of said documents may be obtained at the Engineers' office at 830 Logan Building, 500 Union Street, Seattle, Washington, on request upon a deposit of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each Document. The full amount of the deposit will be refunded if said Documents are returned in good condition within fifteen (15) days after the award of the Contract.

Bidders must be prequalified in compliance with Oregon Revised Statutes 279.008. Prequalification forms, completely filled out, shall be mailed to the City Recorder, City Hall, Boardman, Oregon, at least ten (10) days prior to the bidding date.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or bid bond, executed on the prescribed form, payable to the City of Boardman, Oregon, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 10925 as amended by Executive Order No. 11114. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the Specifications.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a bond for faithful performance of the Contract in the full amount of the Contract price.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals, to postpone the award of the Contract for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days, and to accept that proposal which is the best interests of the City of Boardman, Oregon.
