days prior to the date of the hearing.

Section 52. **Record of Amendments.** The county clerk shall maintain a record of amendments to the text and map of this ordinance in a form convenient for use by the public.

ADMINISTRATION, ENFORCEMENT, AND INTERPRETATION

Section 53. **Enforcement.** The county court or its designated officer shall have the power and duty to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 54. **Appeal to the County Court.** An action or ruling of the planning commission authorized by this ordinance may be appealed to the county court within 15 days after the decision has rendered its decision by filing written notice with the county clerk. If no appeal is taken within the 15-day period, the decision of the commission shall be final. If an appeal is filed, the county court shall receive a report and recommendation from the planning commission and shall hold a public hearing on the appeal. Notice of the public hearing shall be by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the county ten days prior to the date of the hearing.

Section 55. **Form of Petitions, Application, and Appeals.**

(1) Petitions, applications, and appeals provided for in this ordinance shall be made on forms provided for the purpose or as otherwise prescribed by the county in order to assure the fullest practical presentation of pertinent facts and to maintain a permanent record. Where plans submitted shall show the site and its relationship to adjacent property at a suitable scale and with sufficient supplemental drawings or material to show all elements necessary to indicate the dimensions and arrangement of the proposed development and its relationship to surrounding properties and streets.

(2) Applications for building registration permits shall be accompanied by plans and specifications, drawn to scale, showing the actual shape and dimensions of the lot to be built upon; the exact size and location of the buildings and other structures, existing and proposed; the existing and intended use of each building, structure or part thereof; the number of families to be accommodated, if any; and such other information as is needed to determine their conformance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 56. **Interpretation.** Where the conditions imposed by a provision of this ordinance are less restrictive than comparable conditions imposed by any other provisions of this ordinance or any other ordinance, resolution, or regulation, the provisions which are more restrictive shall govern.

Section 57. **Severability.** The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 58. **Penalty.** A person violating a provision of this ordinance shall be subject to the provisions of ORS 215.180 and 215.990.
