Ullman Requests Stock Feed Relief
 Congressman Al Ullman has requested Secretary of Agriculture Freeman to take action to relieve the livestock feed shortage in drought-affected areas of the Pacific Northwest.
 In a letter to the Secretary, Ullman urged that lands diverted from agricultural production under federal farm programs be used for pasture to supplement local feed supplies.
 The 2nd District Congressman also asked Freeman to give other appropriate assistance if a break in the current dry spell does not bring relief to livestock producers.

Ullman Requests Stock Feed Relief

Specialists Talk On Inheritance
 Russell Wills and Clair Reynolds, tax specialists of Portland, spoke Wednesday, June 8, to interested persons on problems concerning inheritance taxes at a meeting in the Lexington Grange Hall.
 They told of possible solutions to these problems by planning ahead of time.
 Lack of "liquidity" or cash money is the greatest problem because many people have real estate and personal property but little cash on hand to pay inheritance taxes, they said. In planning ahead, one must be sure to make a will and then prepare for needed cash with such means as insurance or trust.

Wills formerly worked in the Internal Revenue tax department and is now an attorney

and certified public accountant with special experience in this field. Reynolds is the special representative for the trust department of the First National Bank of Oregon in the eastern part of the state.
