IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR THE COUNTY OF MORROW

IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF Jack A. Frisbie, Max Hellberg, and W. C. Starke FOR THE FORMATION OF AN IRRIGATION DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY OF MORROW AND STATE OF OREGON

The petition of Jack A. Frisbie, Max Hellberg, W. C. Starke, praying for the organization of an irrigation district in said Morrow County, State of Oregon, said district to include the lands hereinafter described, having been presented to the Court on the 10th day of June, 1966, at 9:00 o'clock A.M., and the Court having heard and considered the testimony and evidence as to all the matters and things in said petition set forth, and other matters necessary to be heard by the Court, and the Court having duly considered the said petition and all of said testimony and evidence, and being now fully advised in the premises, finds and declares as follows:

That the said petition is in legal and proper form and was duly presented to said Court on the 10th day of June, 1966, at 9:00 o'clock A.M., the same being a regular meeting of the said Court;

That the petition is signed by a majority of the owners of lands, or holders of title, or evidence of title to lands within the boundaries of said proposed irrigation district, as set forth in said petition, all being duly qualified to sign said petition, and as hereinafter described;

That said petition contains a request in proper for the election of three directors at large, from the district;

That said petition is accompanied by a good and sufficient bond which has heretofore been approved by the Court in double the amount of the probable cost of organizing said district, conditioned that the bondsmen will pay all the costs in event that said organization is not effected;

That the said petition sets forth the boundaries of said proposed irrigation district as required by law, and prays that the same be organized into an irrigation district under the provisions of the laws of the State of Oregon;

That all of the lands lying within the boundaries of said proposed irrigation district lie in Morrow County, Oregon;

That the said petition together with the notice given by the signers of said petition stating the time and place of meeting of said Court at which same would be presented has been duly and regularly published as required by law for at least four weeks immediately before the time at which the same was to be presented, on the following days, namely: May 12, May 19, May 26, June 2, and June 9, 1966, being five issues thereof, in the Heppner Gazette-Times a weekly newspaper printed and published in Heppner, Oregon, Morrow County, and of general circulation during all of said time in said County and State, and that said petition and notice was not published in a supplement thereof;

That all of the lands included within the boundaries of said proposed irrigation district are susceptible to irrigation from a common or combined source, and by the same system of works;

That the court has heard and considered all of the petitions and objections of parties who do not desire to be included in said irrigation district and this Court finds that all of said petitions and objections are not well taken and that the same will hereby be denied and district formed as hereinafter set forth;

That all things and acts required by law precedent to entry of the order hereinafter set forth, have happened and been performed and it is therefore ORDERED by the Court as follows:

That the prayer of the petition be and the same is hereby GRANTED: That the boundaries of the said irrigation district shall be and they are hereby established and defined as follows:

Beginning at a section corner common to sections twenty-nine, thirty, thirty-one and thirty-two of township four North, range twenty-six East, Willamette Meridian; thence East to the Northeast corner of section thirty-two, township four North, range twenty-six East; thence North to the Northwest corner of section twenty-eight, township four North, range twenty-six East; thence West to the Southwest corner of section twenty, township four North, range twenty-six East; thence North to the Northwest corner of section twenty, township four North, range twenty-six East; thence West to the Southwest corner of section eighteen, township four North, range twenty-six East; thence North to the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of section eighteen, township four North, range twenty-six East; thence East to the Northeast corner of section eight, township three North, range twenty-seven East; thence South to the Southeast corner of section five, township three North, range twenty-seven East; thence West to the Southwest corner of section five, township three North, range twenty-seven East; thence South to the Southwest corner of section eight, township three North, range twenty-seven East; thence East to the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of section nine, township three North, range twenty-seven East; thence South to the Southeast corner of section nine, township three North, range twenty-seven East; thence West to the Southwest corner of section nine, township three North, range twenty-seven East; thence West to the Southwest corner of section eight, township three North, range twenty-seven East; thence West to the Southwest corner of section seven, township three North, range twenty-seven East; thence West to the Southwest corner of section eleven, township three North, range twenty-six East; thence West to the Southwest corner of section eleven, township three North, range twenty-six East; thence North to the Northwest corner of section two, township three North, range twenty-six East being the place of beginning; all within ranges twenty-six East and twenty-seven East, and townships three and four North, Willamette Meridian, Morrow County, Oregon.

That the name of such proposed district is hereby designated as "Boardman Irrigation District," and by that name the said district shall hereafter be known;

That the number of directors of said district as requested in said petition be three, and that they be elected from the district at large;

That notice of said election shall be given by the Clerk of this Court as and for the notice of this Court, which notice shall describe the boundaries hereby established, and shall designate the name of such proposed district, and give the voting place therein and that such notice shall be published once each week for at least four consecutive weeks prior to such election in the Heppner Gazette-Times, a weekly newspaper published at Heppner, within said County and State;

That such notice shall require the electors to cast ballots which shall contain the words "Irrigation District — Yes," or "Irrigation District — No," or words equivalent thereto, and also the names of the persons nominated to fill the elective offices of directors.

That the territory included within the boundaries above described shall for the purpose of said election constitute one election precinct, and that said election shall be held at Max Hellberg ranch on Oct. 3, 1966.

That the following persons are hereby appointed clerks of said election, to-wit: Max Hellberg, Marilyn Hellberg, W. C. Starke and Jack A. Frisbie; said election shall be conducted as nearly as possible in accordance with the general election laws of the State of Oregon.
