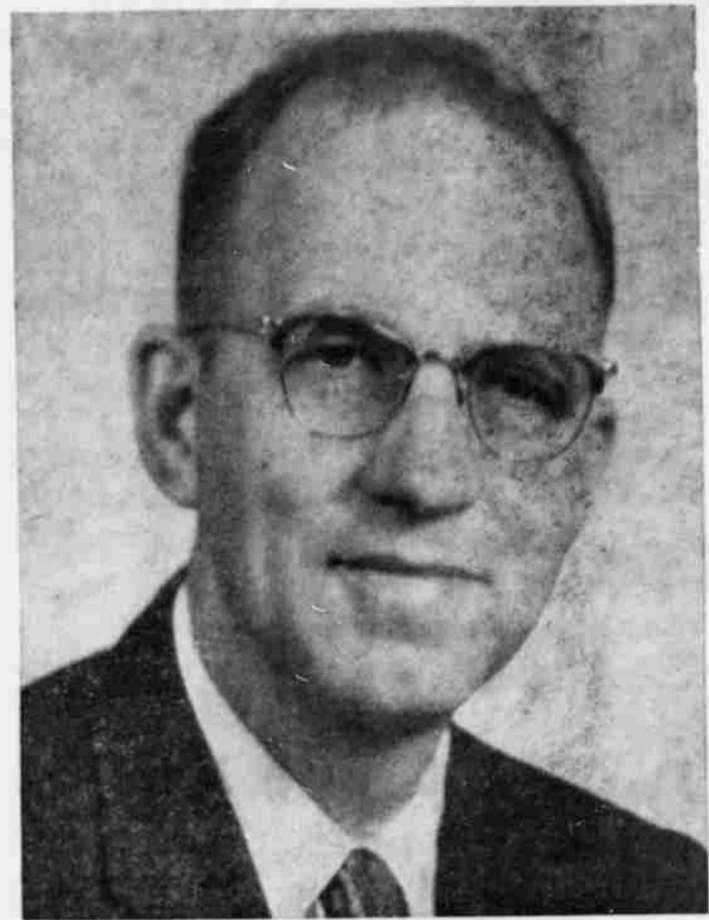
**ROBERT DUNCAN**
