**Snow is Needed For Water Supply**

No one looks forward to a hard winter, but it will take above average snowfalls in Oregon this season to provide adequate irrigation supplies for the 1967 growing season.

Mrs. Elvera Horrell, Oregon State University Extension agricultural economist said that although precipitation was near normal in Western Oregon and the Cascades during the year ending September 1, it was only about half of normal in Eastern Oregon. Old timers in some areas likened the dry situation to the drought years of the 1930's, she said.

U. S. Soil Conservation Service reports show that more than a third of the reservoirs had little or no carryover at the end of the season and about half closed with a carryover of about 80 per cent of average.

Mrs. Horrell said lack of moisture caused fall grain seeding to run behind schedule in portions of the Columbia Basin. Gilliam, Umatilla, Sherman and southern Morrow counties are particularly dry, she noted. Elsewhere in the state, fall grain seeding was well along by the end of the last week of October. The economist also noted that range feed conditions improved in September, but are still far below last year and the average for this date.
