Rock Creek Dam Drillings Start

Test drillings are underway for a proposed dam on Rock Creek, some 25 miles from Heppner, that would provide irrigation for farmers below the dam, most of them in Umatilla county. Orville Cutsforth reported to the Chamber of Commerce here April 24.

Three wells have been drilled to the present, and two more are yet to be done, he said. Cutsforth said that they had drilled 112 feet but found all of the formation "bad."

Ralph Richards, work conservator of the Heppner Soil and Water Conservation district, said Tuesday that the proposed project is being developed through the Gilliam county district, but the Heppner district co-signed on the Small Watershed project because the dam would be located in Morrow county.

Richards said that size of the dam is yet to be determined, depending on a vote of the members in the newly-formed irrigation district. Many of the would-be irrigators are in the Olex district.

Cutsforth said there is a possibility of the dam going as high as 120 feet, and it would back water up three canyons.

While primary use would be for irrigation, it would also include some use for recreation and flood control, Richards said. Recreation use probably would be limited because most of the water would be utilized in summer for irrigation.

The proposed dam site is located on the Lone Rock road, just a mile or so from the Elmer and Roger Palmer ranches in Eightmile.

Farm Laborer Faces Two Charges Here

LaVergne Krumwiede, who was recently indicted by the Morrow county grand jury on charges of sodomy and contributing to the delinquency of a minor, has been committed to the state hospital in Pendleton for treatment on order of Judge Henry Kaye of district court, Pendleton.

Krumwiede, who had been working in the Heppner area as a farm laborer, was arraigned on the two charges in circuit court here by Judge William Wells on April 13. Bail was fixed at \$2500 on each charge, and Krumwiede was held in the Pendleton jail in lieu of bail until the time of his commitment.

Sheriff C. J. D. Bauman said the man attempted to hang himself while he was in the Morrow county jail on April 12, and Robert Abrams, who was appointed his attorney by circuit court, said Krumwiede made a second unsuccessful attempt to take his own life while in the Pendleton jail.

Abrams said that the court will seek to determine whether the man is able to appear at a hearing here next week on the two charges against him.
