Grain Movement Gains Momentum

Grain movement in Oregon continued to gain momentum in August with Oregon Department of Agriculture inspectors checking 297,076 tons for export from Portland and Astoria compared with 224,534 tons in July. Incoming grain at Portland and Astoria inspected by the department totaled 350,239 tons in August. The previous month there were 241,836 tons.

At Pendleton the department inspectors made inspections on 59,967 tons of grain for diversion and at Merrill on 33,061 tons of grain. Protein analyses made during August were slightly under those for July with the August total 2.914, while the previous month there were 2.920.
