There will be submitted to the legal voters thereof the question of contracting a bonded indebtedness in the sum of One Million Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand (\$1,250,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of providing funds with which to acquire, construct, reconstruct, improve, repair, equip and furnish school buildings or additions thereto and to acquire, develop and improve all property, both real and personal, appurtenant thereto or connected therewith within the district owned by the district in and for said district, to fund outstanding indebtedness, and to pay for any costs incurred by said area education district in issuing and selling such bonds. The bond authority, if authorized by the legal voters, shall be in lieu of the serial levy of \$120,000.00 per year previously authorized and said special levy authority shall terminate upon approval of this bond authority.

"No," and the voter shall place a cross (X) between the word "Bonds" and the word "Yes" or between the word "Bonds" and the word "No," to signify his choice. The polls for the reception of the ballots cast for or against the contraction of said indebtedness will, on said day and date and at the place aforesaid, be opened at the hour of 8 o'clock A.M. and remain open until the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. of the same day, at which hour the same shall be closed.

Upon Question of Increasing Tax Levy Over Amount Limited by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held in Blue Mountain Area Education District of Umatilla and Morrow Counties, State of Oregon, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on April 2, 1968, at the polling places listed for the bond election published herewith, in said school district, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said district the question of increasing the tax levy for the fiscal year 1968-1969 over the amount limited by section 11, article XI, of the Constitution of Oregon. The reasons for increasing such levy are:

The funds are needed to operate Blue Mountain Community College. The district has no tax base.

The amount of tax, in excess of the constitutional limitation, proposed to be levied for said fiscal year is \$389,921, which, expressed as a rate of levy, is estimated at ninety cents (.90) per thousand dollars of true cash value of taxable property within the district.
