ORDER MODIFYING ANGLING FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS

WHEREAS, the Oregon State Game Commission at its stated meeting held on November 3 and 16, 1967, pursuant to ORS 496.190 by written findings and determinations established the open seasons for angling for salmon and jack salmon;

WHEREAS, in the judgment of said Commission, it is in the best interests of the salmon and jack salmon resource in the Columbia River that said findings and determinations be modified by closing to angling for salmon and jack salmon for a limited period a portion of said stream;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the findings and determinations of the Oregon State Game Commission adopted at the stated meeting of said Commission on November 3 and 16, 1967, respectively, hereby are modified as follows:

That the season is closed to angling for salmon and jack salmon in that portion of the Columbia River from the Astoria-Megler Bridge to Bonneville Dam from 12:01 a.m., May 27, 1968 to 12:01 a.m., June 22, 1968; and in that portion of Columbia River from Bonneville Dam to the Oregon-Washington state line from 12:01 a.m., May 27, 1968, to 12:01 a.m., July 27, 1968.
