**NOTICE OF BOND SALE**  
**CITY OF IRRIGON WATER REVENUE BONDS**

Sealed bids will be received at the City Hall, City of Irrigon, Oregon, until 7:30 o'clock P.M. on the 9th day of July, 1968 for the purchase of \$36,000 in Water Revenue Bonds to be issued for the purpose of constructing a city water system.

Said bonds are not general obligations of the City but will be payable solely from water revenues of the system after provision only for the operating and maintenance expenses thereof.

Said bonds will be dated as of the date of delivery, and be in denominations of \$500 each, with interest coupons attached and will bear interest payable January 1 and July 1 thereafter.

Said bonds will be numbered 1 to 72 inclusive and mature annually on January 1 in consecutive numerical order as follows:

\$500 each year starting with January 1, 1971 and continuing through January 1, 1986.  
 \$1,000 each year starting with January 1, 1987 and continuing through January 1, 2000.  
 \$1,500 each year starting with January 1, 2001 and continuing through January 1, 2008.

If the bonds are purchased by the U. S. Government acting through the Farmers Home Administration, the bonds will be in the form of one or more installment bonds, without interest coupons, with approximately equal annual payments of principal plus interest.

During the first five years after the date of the bonds, none of them will be callable by the City prior to maturity. After the first five years, at the option of the City, any bond or bonds may be called for payment on any interest due date, without penalty.

Said bonds will be issued pursuant to the provisions of the City of Irrigon Charter, and will constitute a first pledge upon the aforesaid revenues derived from the operation of the water system, and will be payable, as to both principal and interest, at the principal office of the City.

Bids will be submitted only on the basis of the face amount of the bonds, without discount or premium. Each bid must specify an interest rate of 4.50% or less because the U. S. Government through the Farmers Home Administration has agreed to take them at that rate.

The further terms and provisions of the bonds, including all covenants relative thereto and provision for their security, are set forth in the Bond Ordinance adopted by the City Council. Copies of the Ordinance may be obtained from the City Recorder, City Hall, Irrigon, Oregon.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope addressed to the City Recorder, City Hall, and marked "Bids for Water Revenue Bonds". Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check payable to City of Irrigon in the sum of \$1,800.00. The check will secure payment for said bonds within a reasonable time and will be forfeited as liquidated damages in event of default on the part of the successful bidder. Checks from unsuccessful bidders will be returned promptly after determination of the successful bidder.

Bids will be opened and tabulated promptly after the above-stated closing time. The right to reject any and all bids is expressly reserved by the City. Promptly after the bids have been opened and fully considered, the City Council will, by ordinance or resolution, accept the bid of the successful bidder.
