He was a member of Greenfield Grange in Boardman.

Funeral services were held Monday, July 8, in Boardman at the Community church, at 2 p.m., with the Rev. Jack Naff, pastor of the First Christian church, Hermiston, in charge of services. Burial was in Boardman Riverview Cemetery with Burns Mortuary in charge.

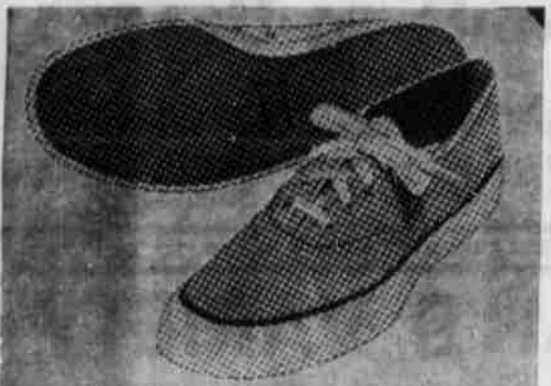
