**Renewal Given EOC On Accreditation**

Accreditation for Eastern Oregon College has been renewed by the Northwest Association of Secondary and Higher Schools for the maximum five-year period, according to Dr. A. M. Rempel, president. The action was taken by the Commission on Higher Schools at their summer meeting, and was reported to the Eastern Oregon College president by the executive director, James F. Bemis.

The Northwest Association is one of two accrediting commissions who periodically review collegiate programs to assess how well educational standards are maintained. The National Commission on Accreditation of Teacher Education will make a report on their review at a meeting in Denver in late July.

Dr. Carlos E. Easley directed both study reports for the institution during the year preceding the April visit of the two teams of higher education experts.
