Bureau to Start Study of South River Resources

The Bureau of Reclamation has been funded to begin a reconnaissance investigation of the Columbia South Side Project during this fiscal year.

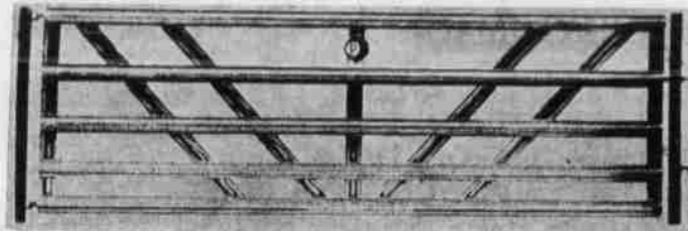
Plans are for the field crews to begin their work during the week of October 21 and hopes for it to be completed by June, 1969. The area included in the study lies along the south side of the Columbia River from the vicinity of Butter Creek westward to the Deschutes River and extends south to approximately 1500 feet elevation. The principal objectives will be to determine the potential for land and water resource development and to identify areas which warrant further study now and in the future.

A basic part of this investigation is a land classification survey to identify the lands suitable for irrigation development and classify them into appropriate irrigability classes. Field crews make many soil borings, collect samples for laboratory analysis, and observe and map various other characteristics which affect irrigability.

Field crews need to have access to all lands within the study area in order to complete this study. Early completion of this study could mean a great boost to the agricultural potential of Morrow county. Cooperation of landowners would be greatly appreciated.
