

Christmas to Bring Phone Call Rush

Pacific Northwest Bell expects its customers to make more than 282,000 long distance calls on Christmas Day.

"That's over 50 percent more than are placed on a normal business day," according to PNB manager, Dale Slusher.

"And if everyone waits till Christmas Day to make his call," he said, "there are going to be delays and disappointments, even with the additional circuits we can make available."

The phone company has several suggestions for beating the Christmas call rush:

"Place your call early. The rates for week-end and evening calling are the same, and as low, as they will be on Christmas Day.

"Whenever and wherever possible, dial the call yourself. The call will be completed faster and it will enable operators to handle more calls of the type that must be placed with them."

"Know in advance the number you are calling. You can dial—at no charge—Directory Assistance operators in Oregon by dialing "1-555-1212", or outside Oregon by dialing "1", the appropriate Area Code and then "555-1212". Where direct dialing is not available, operators will assist customers in advance to obtain the number they want to call.

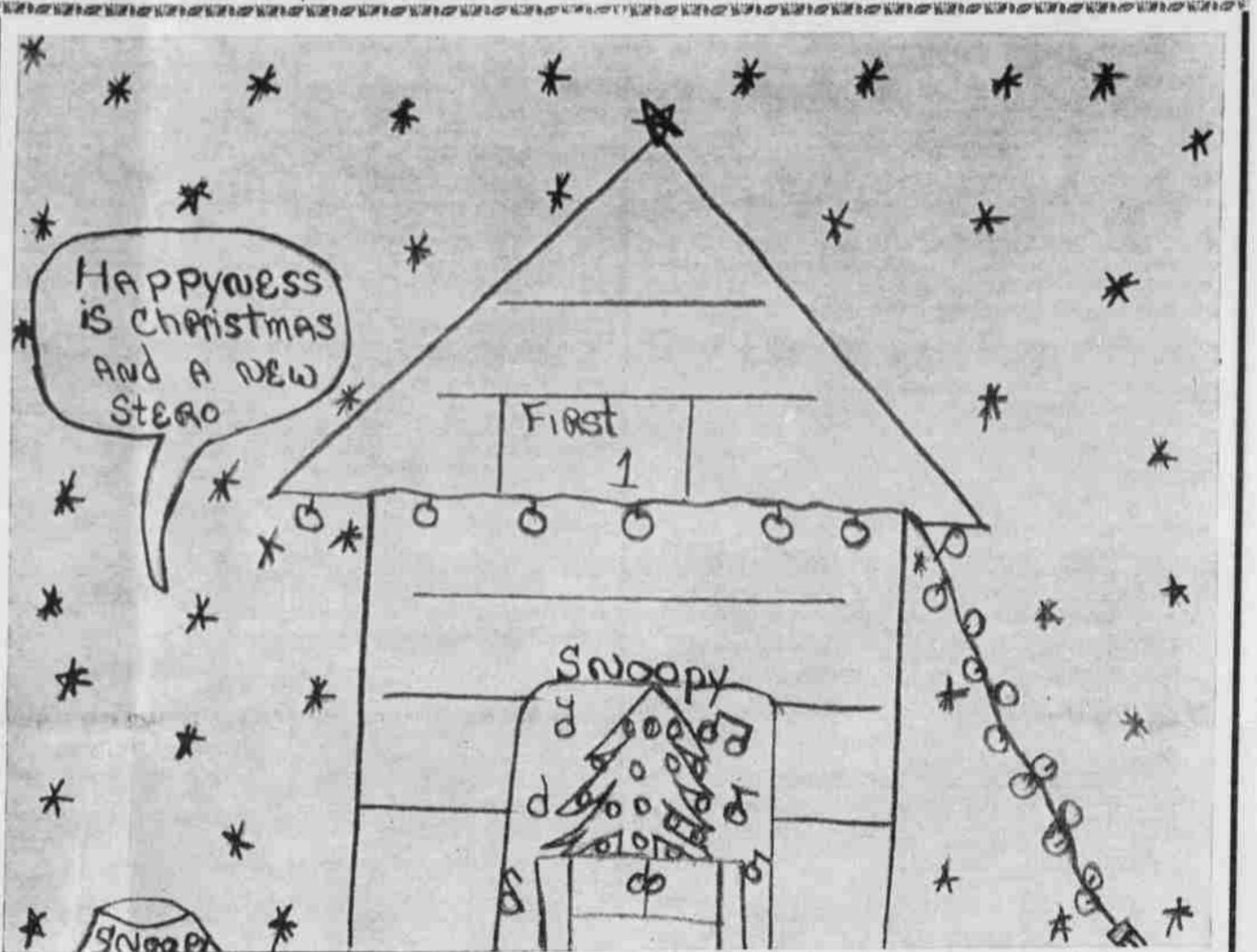

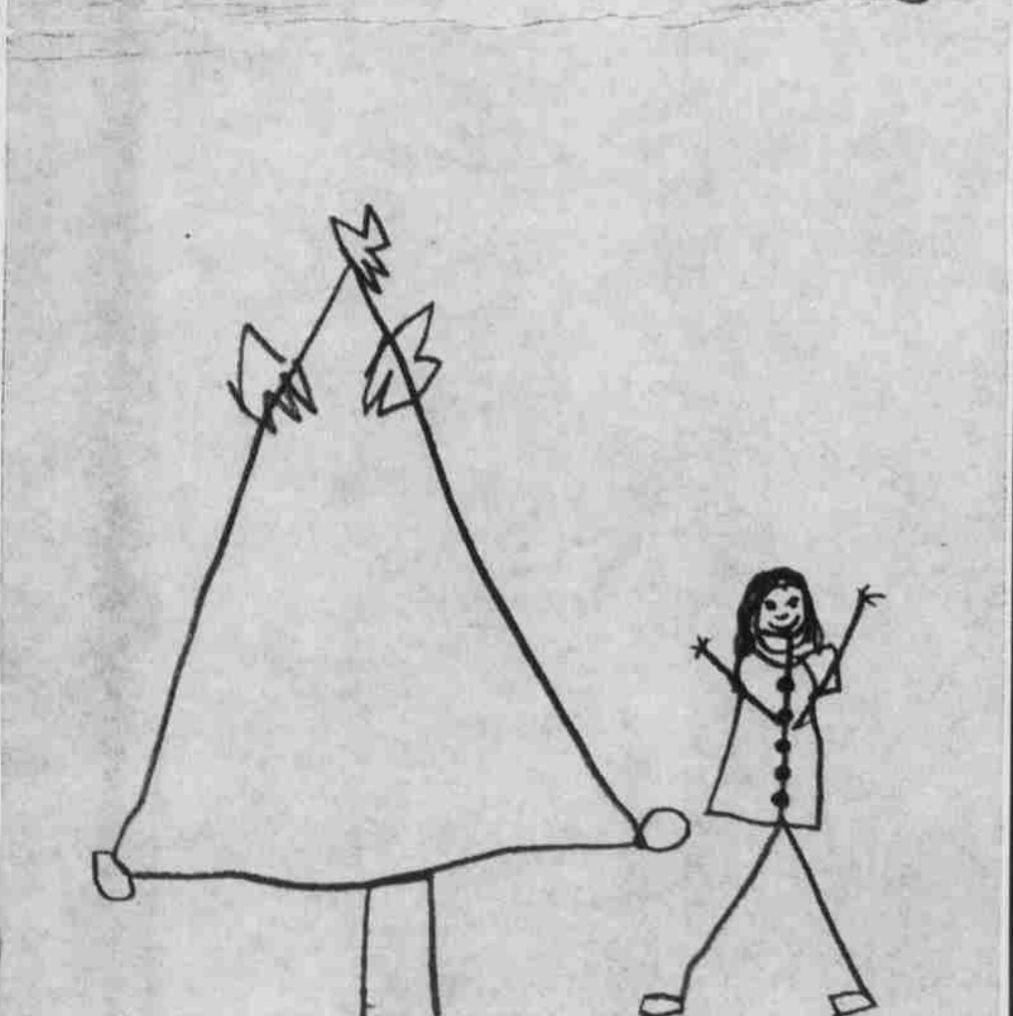

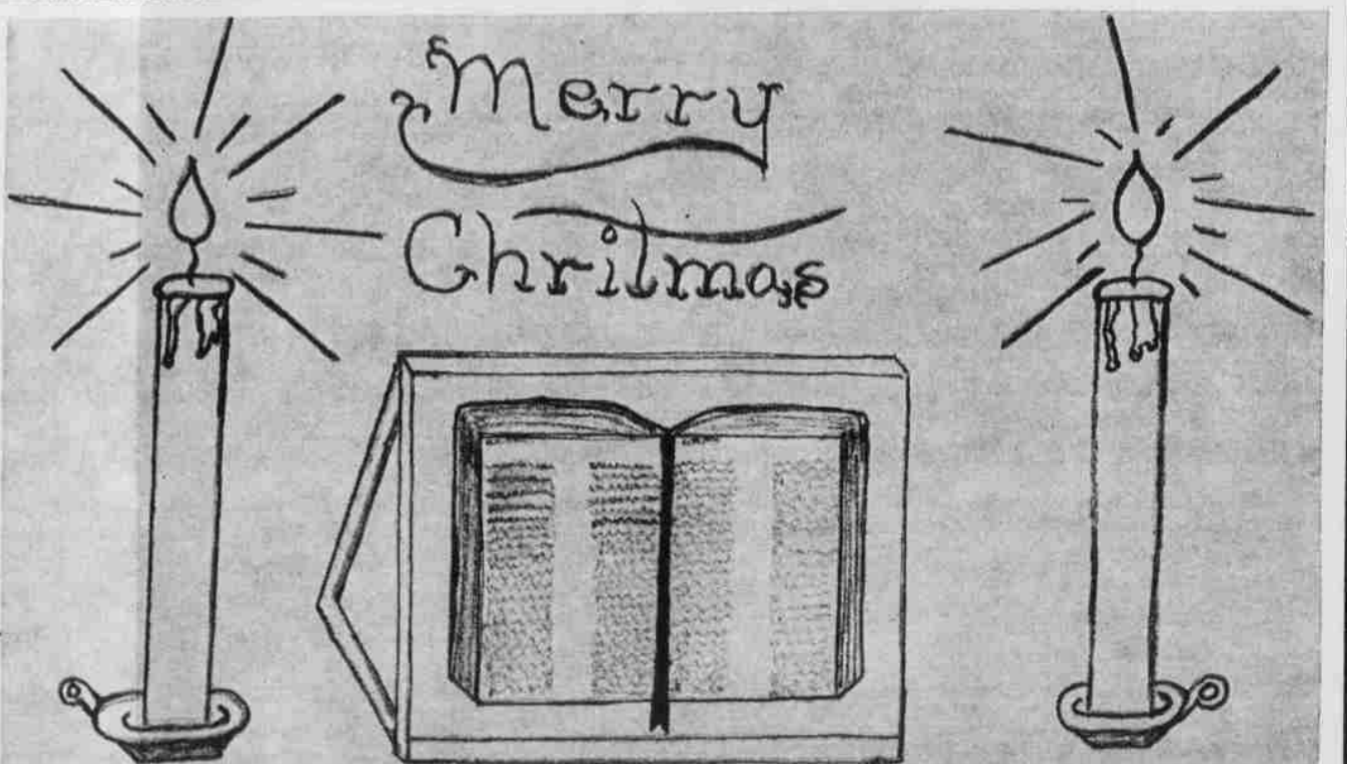
