## Lightning Storm Sets House Ablaze

**IRRIGON**—A bolt of lightning struck the James McRae home, two miles west of Irrigon Saturday night during the electric storm, setting the house afire. The bolt burned foliage from a tree east of the house, struck an iron vent pipe and passed through the building, striking a locust tree 10 feet away on the west side of the house.

The incident occurred at the height of the thunderstorm which knocked out power, plunging the area into darkness and making the fire siren inoperative. Possible total loss to the house was no doubt deferred by the downpour of rain. Approximately two inches fell in less than two hours.
