Loan Dispensation Bill Gets Backing

Senator Bob Packwood has joined in co-sponsoring legislation providing for greater flexibility in making loans to college students under the National Defense Education Act. Under the existing law, Congress must pass legislation appropriating funds to pay the interest on loans made under the guaranteed student loan program. Because of rapidly changing economic conditions, namely inflation resulting in increased interest rates, the Congress finds it cannot expedite legislation quickly enough to provide safeguards that loans will be repaid. The new legislation would provide continued funding to pay for the interest on loans to college students and would allow the Commissioner of Education to raise and lower the amount of interest paid by the federal government. "I feel it is my obligation as a lawmaker to do everything within my power to open the door wherever possible for all Americans to advance their education," Packwood said. "This represents another step in that direction."
