Booklets containing the 1969 regulations for upland game birds, waterfowl and small game are now in the hands of license dealers throughout the state and ready for distribution to hunters, the Game Commission announced today.
The booklet contains a summary page of all seasons, open areas, and bag limits for ease in understanding. Rules pertaining to the public shooting areas are also listed in table form. Hunters will find a handy shooting timetable in the back of the booklet which lists daily shooting hours for upland game birds and waterfowl.
Hunters are urged to check the booklet regarding refuges and closures, rules relating to firearms, possession and transportation of game, and other restrictions.
