Said riverbed tract is described as follows:
All state-owned submersible and submerged lands in the bed of the Columbia River lying within 130 feet measured at right angles to the high water line fronting and abutting the following described parcel of real property, to-wit:
A tract of land lying in Government Lots 1 and 2 of Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 26 East, Willamette Meridian, Morrow County, Oregon, said tract being more particularly described as follows:
