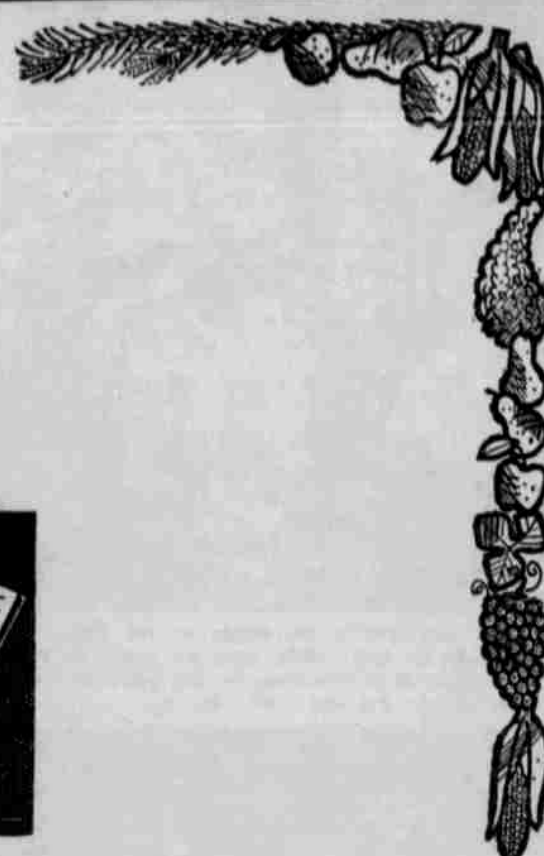




This Is A Time For
