Reduced Interest Rate on Commodities

Commodity Storage Loan interest rate, from Commodity Credit Corporation, was reduced as of March 30, 1972. The new rate, of 5.52 percent will be applied to all loans made on and after that date.

The storage structure loans are made available for the purchase and construction of needed on the farm storage of small grains. These loans are for a maximum of 85 percent of eligible costs and repayable in four equal installments, plus interest, over a period of five years.

Farmers interested in erecting farm storage may visit the county ASCS office for specific program requirements.
