TEACHER OF THE YEAR The Teacher of the Year Award for 1972 was given to Mr. Dennis McKay.

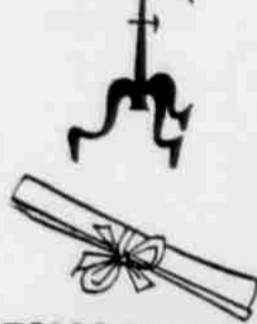
