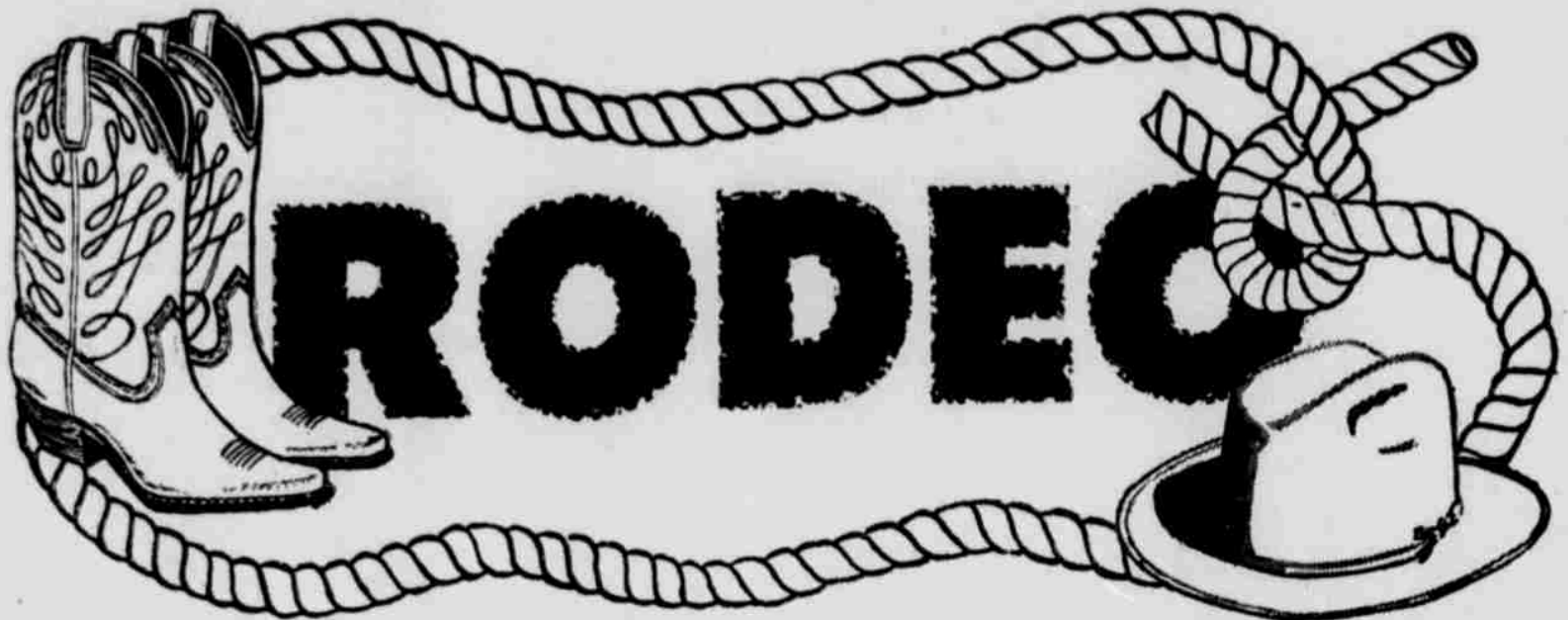

Some asparagus growers have discontinued cutting in the area already but Millers plan to cut for one more week anyway.
