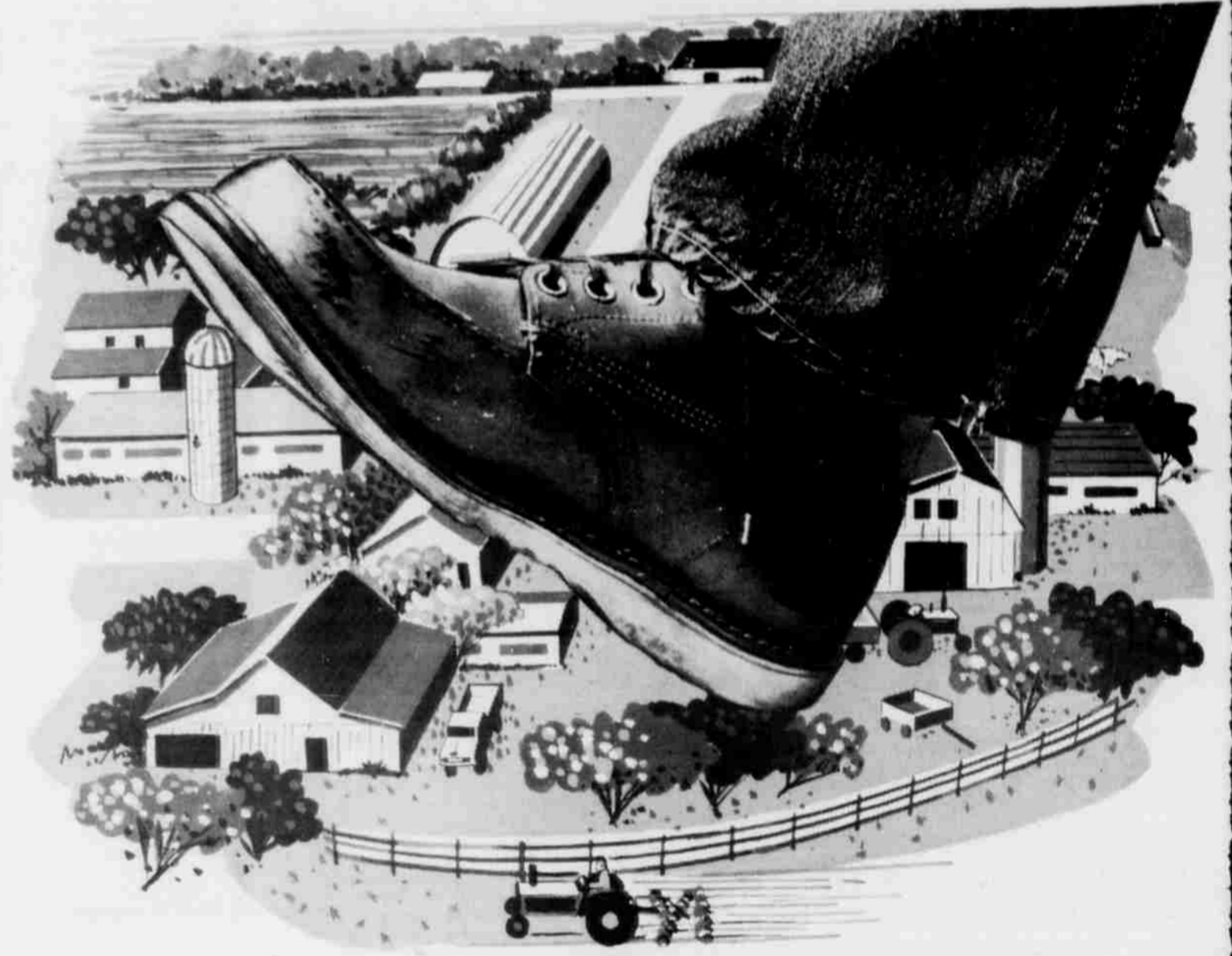

5. Be Careful Around Water Holes, Wells and Ponds. Learn How to Swim and Never Go in Water by Yourself.
6. Electricity and Chemicals Can be Dangerous. Make Your Electrical Wiring Safe and Keep Chemicals from Children.
7. Learn the Methods of First Aid. Keep a Kit Handy and Always apply First Aid When an Accident Occurs.
8. Have a Plan of Action That you and Your Family Follow that Would Bring Help Immediately.
