## Foreign Policy

## Vietnam

The President has won agreement from Turkey to place a total ban on the growing of opium poppy. Made an agreement with France to assist in halting traffic of drugs, stepped up arrests of pushers. Combined, these actions are finally turning the tide against the drug scourge.
