

PRODUCTION & LAND USE COMMITTEE - BILL RIETMANN, CH.

1. We encourage individual producers to work on the problem of wild oats and rye. We also request cost sharing from REAP for weed control.
2. When new varieties are released we recommend that a field inspection be made and if the field is passed the grower be allowed to sell certified seed. No seed sample would be necessary.

3. We recommend continual funding of the present level or better for feed grain research.
4. We recommend that the OWGL appoint a special committee to keep abreast of regulations on the use of herbicides and other chemicals by the FDA and DEQ.
5. A guideline developed by an interagency group is being prepared to establish recommendation for land management soil conservation of newly developed soil.
6. We would support long range contracts for conservation practices in the Columbia-Basin summer fallow area.

7. We urged the support of OWGL in the efforts to pass a state wide weed law which could be enforced by local weed districts or county government.

PUBLIC AFFAIRS & FINANCE COMMITTEE - GEORGE LUCIANI, CH.

1. We feel the football scholarship should be changed and given to some graduate student in agriculture or home economics that would relate to the wheat industry.
2. We recommend educational programs through schools, extension service and workshops on safety program.

TAXATION & LEGISLATION COMMITTEE - JACK SUMNER, CH.

- Farm Use Assessment**
1. We oppose a statewide property tax to achieve equalization of educational revenue, we also oppose a property tax on income producing property only. We think all classes of property should support education.

We favor a five year moving average price for determining income on farm use as a means of stabilizing county tax bases instead of two years.

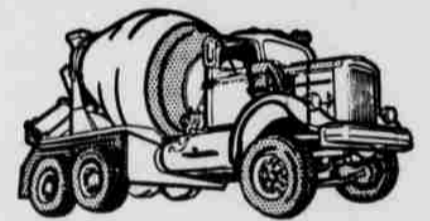

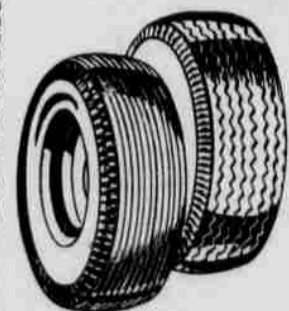
