We favor farm use value for determining federal and state inheritance taxes.

We feel the present inheritance tax is unfair to farmers.

To better acquaint assessors with personal property values, specifically farm equipment, we suggest assessors be required to attend some farm and machinery auctions.

We would like to commend the Oregon legislatures for passing the Farm Deferral Law which taxes land on the basis of its income producing ability.

- Workman's Compensation
- The OWGL should continue work and investigation efforts to lower agricultural insurance rates.
- Agriculture Employee Relations
- We recognize the right of agricultural laborers to organize for collective bargaining.
- Agriculture Research
- In order to educate the executive and legislative branches of state government and extension we recommend that OWGL be available to go to Salem to assist our rural legislators whenever needed.

- Scenic Waterways and Wilderness Areas
- We recommend Scenic-Waterways Law be changed to remove the overriding or veto power of the Governor, and have the Legislature make the final designations. We also recommend a law change to allow land owners to protect their own property from destruction.
- Environment and Agriculture
- In order that OWGL keep abreast and defend legislation and administrative policy to protect the interest of the agricultural industry and production of our nation's food supply we recommend that our legislative council and executive secretary keep the executive committee of the OWGL informed.

- Corporate Farming
- We support legislation which would prohibit vertical integration of non-agricultural corporations in agriculture.
- Highway Bonding and Use Funds
- O.S.H.A.
- We question the constitutional right of the OSHA inspectors to enter on private land and enforce their regulations.

WHEAT USE AND RESEARCH COMMITTEE - DICK McELLEGOTT, CH.

- We recommend a committee be appointed by the Executive Committee to investigate the changing of Oregon State tax structure on alcohol when used for fuel in internal combustion engines, and further recommend that the recent law passed in Nebraska concerning this issue be thoroughly studied for guidelines for similar legislation for Oregon.
