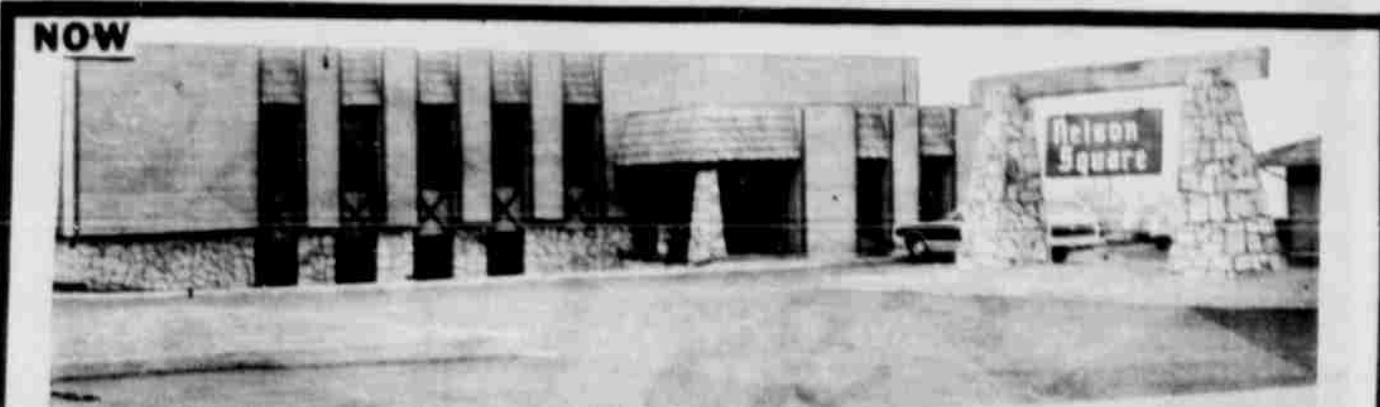

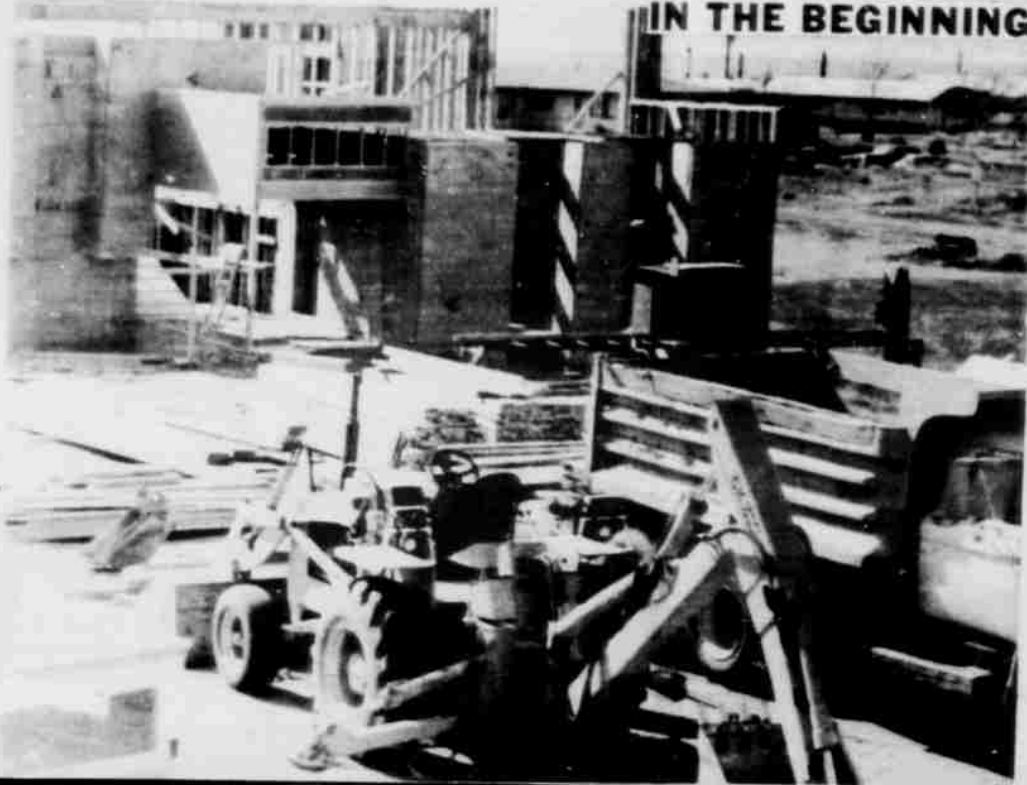
### Open House at Nelson Square

Nelson Square the latest development at Boardman will have Open House this Saturday from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. Santa Claus will be there to greet his young friends, and old, from 1 until 3 o'clock in the afternoon. The office building designed for 17 offices has four units rented at this time. Central heating and air conditioning provides summer and winter comfort. The walls are a combination of elm and ash paneling and harvest gold vinyl paper. Beige tweed wall-to-wall carpeting is laid throughout the building. The wood and stone exterior blends with the adjacent building of the Inland Empire Bank also built by W.E. Bill Nelson. The handsome sign swings between two rock pedestals. It is of black laminated redwood with hand routed letters in white enamel. At first the Nelsons had considered calling it "Trafalger Square" after the famous square in the heart of London which contains the Nelson monument and other statues. W.E. Nelson moved to Boardman about three years ago and has since completed approximately \$1 million in commercial and residential structures

in north Morrow County. A native of Portland, he started his construction there. In 1951, he built the 5th housing addition of 500 houses in Richland. His company has built lots of schools, churches and medical buildings.

## Boardman Gets More Phone Lines

Over 7 miles of 75 pair telephone cable will be used at Boardman to replace the present facilities which aren't large enough to take care of the rapidly growing areas on the East and West Wilson Road, served by Eastern Ore. Telephone Co. On this road relief will be needed very shortly or they will be unable to keep to their 2 party service in the Boardman rural area, Mr. Karnopp reported.

More paystations are planned for Boardman as this popular spot hosts more and more tourists. The splendid Marina on the Columbia will get 2 paystations and three additional payphones will be placed at the Boardman interchange. Along with the two emergency phones

they have placed on Hiway 80 North at the Boardman rest area this should take care of the transient needs in this busy community. Two more DDD trunks just added gives this community 11 DDD and 10 operator trunks for a total of 21 long distance circuits.

Three hundred lines have been wired in the Boardman office and this gives a total of 600 lines that can be rapidly placed in service to care for any sudden increase this area may experience.
