Kinzua buys timber

Of seven timber sales during the month of June, two were made to Kinzua Corporation, for more than \$1,300,000, according to H. B. Rudolph, forest supervisor, Umatilla National Forest.

The Porter Creek sale was made June 25 to Kinzua, high bidder, for \$1,334,564. The sale was appraised at \$1,334,479 for an estimated 14 1/2 million board feet of timber, and 3,600 acres of material appraised and sold at 19 cents per acre.

The sale is on the Heppner District in Porter Creek, Juniper Creek, Henry Creek and Colvin Creek drainages in Wheeler and Morrow Counties.

Final bid prices per thousand board feet were: Ponderosa pine, \$91.95; Douglas-fir and western larch, \$90.74; white fir and other coniferous species, \$85.57. Kinzua was the only bidder present.

The Brown L. P. sale was sold June 29 to Kinzua Corporation, high bidder, for \$24,725. The sale was appraised at \$24,720 for an estimated 500,000 board

feet of timber. The sale is on the Heppner District in Morrow County. Final bid prices per thousand board feet were: lodgepole pine and other coniferous species, \$49.45. Kinzua was the only bidder present.

Youth hurt in head-on collision

A head-on collision involving a motorcycle and an automobile threatened the lives of two 16-year-old Boardman youths Tuesday.
