Emmett Davis, dies

Services were held at the Lonerock Community Church July 21 for J. Emmett Davis, 85.

Rev. G.E. Nikander of the Heppner Christian Church officiated.

Sacred songs, "The Old Rugged Cross" and "Amazing Grace" were sung by his grandson, Craig Davis of Genesse, Idaho. Herb Fernandez and his nephew from Laurel Wood sang two songs, accompanying themselves on ukelele and guitar.

Casket bearers were Mr. Davis' six grandsons, Evan and Cris Davis, Scott and Rick McDaniel and Keith and Craig Davis.

Emmett Davis was born at Piper's Gap, Va., Sept. 11, 1888. He was married to Agnes Booth of Azalea, Ore., July 18, 1917. He came to Heppner in 1909 and worked for Arthur Miner several years before moving to Lonerock.

Later, he and Mrs. Davis purchased the Lonerock Hotel & Pastime and livery barn which they operated for a number of years. They later bought the George Perry ranch in Needle Fork, and raised stock since the early 20s.

He was leader of the 4-H sheep club for five years, served on the school board, city council, was a charter member of the Knights of Pythias and an active member of the Lonerock Grange.

In addition to his widow, Agnes, he is survived by his three sons, Homer and Carroll, both of Lonerock, and Lee of Genesse, Idaho; one daughter, Blanch McDaniel, Burns, Ore.; a brother, Brooks Davis, Galox, Va.; three sisters, Lelia Fancy Piper's Gap, Va., Ima Lyons Woodlamin, and Hallie Burchom, Galox, and several nieces and nephews.
