There will be submitted to the qualified voters thereof the question of contracting a bonded indebtedness on the sum of \$1,600,000 for the purpose of providing funds with which to construct, equip or furnish a college building or buildings or additions thereto and to improve all property connected therewith in such community college district.

The vote shall be by ballot upon which shall be the words "Bonds yes" and "Bonds no", and the voter shall place a cross (x) or check mark (✓) between the words "Bonds" and the word "yes" or between the word "Bonds" and the word "no", whichever indicates his choice.

The bonds to be issued shall be general obligation bonds for a term not exceeding twenty (20) years.

The polls for the reception of the ballots cast for or against the contraction of such indebtedness will, on the date and at the place described above, be opened at the hour of 8 a.m. and remain open until the hour of 8 p.m. of the same day, at which hour the polls shall be closed.
