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KERR HOME CANNING LIDS DRAW COMPLAINTS

The outset of the canning season in Oregon has set off a flurry of complaints from home canners that the lids they have purchased this season are not sealing properly. Dr. Jane Wyatt, consumer officer for the Oregon Department of Agriculture, said complaints too numerous to count have reached her office and those of home extension agents and newspaper editors and they all deal with Kerr Glass Manufacturing Corporation of Sand Springs, Oklahoma. She said most of the women complaining are saying that sometimes less than half the lids are sealing. Dr. Wyatt contacted Kerr headquarters in Oklahoma and a spokesman there said there had been a slight change in the character of the lids, but that the company would stand behind the product if proper procedures are used. The change apparently was created when to conform to air pollution standards the company altered its drying process on the rubber seals bonded to the inside of the lids. Dr. Wyatt said the spokesman, who did not wish to be identified, said the sealing material is harder than it has been, but that proper preparation of the caps should produce a good seal.
