PUBLIC NOTICE to Advise Citizens They have the opportunity to serve on Citizen Advisory Committees for Oregon Land Conservation and Development Commission

(a) Membership  
As stated in ORS 197.165, the program for citizen involvement shall include, but not be limited to, an officially recognized citizen advisory committee or committees broadly representative of geographic areas and interests related to land use and land use decisions.

(b) Selection Process  
Citizen advisory committee members shall be selected by an open, public process.

Citizen advisory committee appointees shall receive official notification of their selection.

Citizen advisory committee appointments shall be well publicized.

(c) Responsibilities  
The citizen advisory committee or committees shall be responsible for assisting the governing body with the development of a program that promotes and enhances public participation in land use planning; assisting in the

implementation of the public participation process; making a record of citizen recommendations to be transmitted to the governing body for public assessment; and evaluating the process for public participation being used in land use planning.

The on-going evaluation of the public participation process shall be based on the criteria herein. A record of the evaluation findings shall be transmitted to the State Citizens Involvement Advisory Committee.

(d) Selection date will be December 2, 1974—8:00 p.m., City Hall, Heppner, Oregon 97836.
