MENS DEPT (For George and all the Patriots)

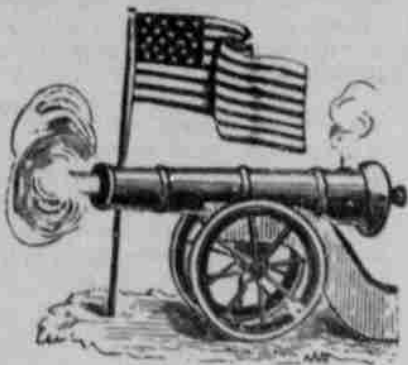

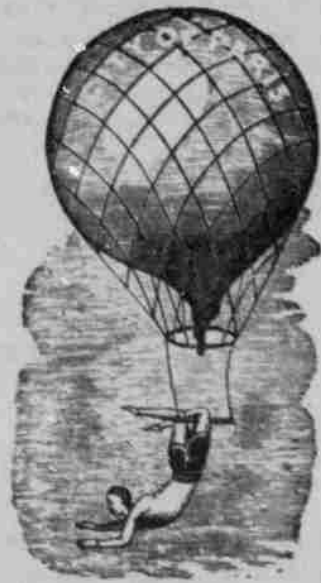
