Cake baking contest

The Morrow County Fair will open Aug. 19 and one of the features for the bakers of the county will be the cake contest sponsored by Wheathearts.

Cakes to be judged at the fair must be in by noon, Tuesday, Aug. 19 as they will be judged at 3 p.m. the same day.

Baking contestants must be men or women over 21 years of age, excluding professional bakers. Everyone must use the same recipe and frosting. The recipe is listed on page 46 of the Morrow County Fair Premium book, or may be obtained at the County Extension Office.

The judges scorecard is based on outside and inside appearance, flavor and frosting. County premiums are \$5, \$3 and \$2 for the first, second and third place winners.

The first place winners from each county will be eligible to enter the State bake-off at the annual convention of the Wheat League in December. Top award will be \$100.

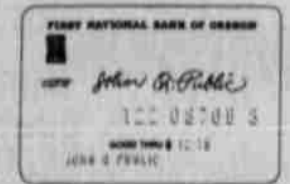
