## LIVESTOCK BRANDING FEE INCREASED

Persons recording livestock brands with the Oregon Dept. of Agriculture will pay a fee of \$25 for the initial recording of the brand starting Oct. 1, 1975. The fee has been \$10. The fee for rerecording of brands every five years remains at \$10. It is set at this figure under a law passed by the 1975 legislative session. The increase in the recording fee was necessary because of increased costs in administering the program under an order dated Sept. 5.
