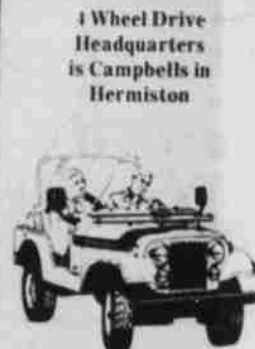

Commodity loan interest rate rises

The interest rate on price support commodity loans and storage facility loans were increased from 6.125 to 7.5 per cent per annum, effective Oct. 1, 1975, according to David McLeod, executive director of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service Office.

The change reflects the increased cost to the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) of borrowing money, according to a notice from the USDA in Washington, D.C.

The new rate will apply to outstanding loans made after Oct. 1, 1974 and new loans disbursed after Oct. 1, 1975.

This adjustment of interest rates on outstanding loans is in accordance with the policy announced last Oct. 1, whereby interest rates are reviewed every six months and adjusted up or down as the need
