SEALED BIDS will be received by the District Ranger or his representative, Heppner Ranger District, Heppner, Oregon 97836, up to and not later than 10 a.m., local time at place of bid opening, Dec. 22, 1975, followed immediately by oral bidding. An estimated 385 MBF, more or less, of ponderosa pine and Douglas fir have been marked for cutting. The minimum acceptance bid per MBF is Ponderosa Pine 36.36 and Douglas fir 38.93. Additional deposit required for slash disposal is \$0.22 per MBF for all species. Additional total lump sum deposit required for road maintenance on National Forest roads over the appraisal route is \$6.00. All included timber shall be given domestic processing. Notice is hereby given that pursuant to Regulation of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. 261.13, all unauthorized livestock found upon National Forest System lands or other lands under Forest Service control within the following area:

T. 5 S., R. 29 E., and T. 6 S., R. 29 E., all Forest Service land in the Deep Creek, Dead Horse Spring, Thompson Flat, Wickup Creek and Potomac Point areas on the Ukiah and Heppner Ranger Districts of the Umatilla National Forest, all in Morrow County State of Oregon; and

T. 5 S., R. 30 E., all Forest Service land in the Dry Five-mile, Silver Creek and Divide Well areas on the Ukiah Ranger District of the Umatilla National Forest, all in Umatilla County, State of Oregon
