Notice is given hereby that John B. Correa has filed an application for the approval of two additional points of diversion from Butter Creek.

Certificate of water right issued to George W. Vincent and recorded at Page 2782, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of 3.51 cubic feet per second from Butter Creek for the irrigation of 4.8 acres in SW¼, NW¼, 22.8 acres in NW¼, SW¼, 33.5 acres in SW¼, SW¼, 16.0 acres in SE¼, SW¼, Section 14; 9.0 acres in SW¼, NE¼, 34.0 acres in SE¼, NE¼, 20.0 acres in NE¼, SE¼, 0.5 acres in SE¼, SE¼, Section 15; 12.5 acres in SW¼, NE¼, 39.0 acres in NE¼, NW¼, 9.0 acres in NW¼, NW¼, and 13.0 acres in SE¼, NW¼, Section 23, T. 1 N., R. 27 E., W.M., with a date of priority of 1877.
