

Inservice & preparation

Teachers return August 31

Morrow County teaching staffs will be returning to the district for fall inservice and classroom preparation on August 31.

The first day for students will be September 7 the day after Labor Day.

A number of new teachers have been added to the staff of the district this year.

Jeri McElligott will teach 5th grade at Lone, George Russell will teach music at Lone, Charles Starr, former math teacher at Heppner has been hired as Principal at Lone.

Linda Murray has been hired as Language Arts teacher at Heppner Jr. High and Rebecca Randall will teach P.E. at Heppner. Chris Borgen will teach Language Arts and coach basketball at Heppner High School. Other new teachers at Heppner are John Dawson, vocal music at both school, Susan Decker, Special Education at Heppner Elementary, Marilyn Post, grade one from the University of Oregon, and Mary Jo Benedict, an Eastern Oregon State College grad, tabled to teach kindergarten.

New teachers at Riverside High School are: Nancy Myklebust, Girls' P.E.; Rick Bateman, Music and Band; Charles Bernard, Social Studies; Sharron Barrick, Language Arts; Gary Turner,

Shop and Vocational; Margaret Rockwood, English and Social Studies.

The district is currently interviewing candidates for two primary positions at Heppner Elementary and a Math teacher and P.E., Co-

operative Work Experience teacher at Heppner High School and an English teacher at Lone High School. When these positions are filled, the staffs will be complete for the coming school year.

New student registration set

Registration of students who are new to Morrow County School and high school students who have scheduling changes to make is set for September 2 and 3 from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

School offices will also be open to receive fees and to provide information to students and parents.

Football practice for Morrow County High Schools will begin August 23, unless the coach has set it at a later date at the individual school.

Student fees are the same as last year except there will be no shop fee for secondary students and no student body fee for elementary students.

A physical examination is required of all beginning students who will be entering school for the first time in

Kindergarten or for first graders who have not been in Kindergarten, and for all ninth grade students.

Parents and students who have questions regarding any matters related to registration and entry into school are encouraged to contact their school office.
