**NOTICE OF PROPOSED ABANDONMENT**  
Notice is hereby given that the Interstate Commerce Commission is being requested to issue a certificate of public convenience and necessity permitting abandonment by Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Company and abandonment of operation by Union Pacific Railroad Company over a portion of Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Company branch line trackage known as the Umatilla Branch extending from railroad milepost 10.63 near Umatilla, Oregon, in a westerly direction to railroad milepost 18.15 near Irrigon, Oregon, a distance of 7.52 miles in Umatilla and Morrow Counties, Oregon. The trackage proposed to be abandoned includes the non-agency station of Irrigon.

The interest of employees will be protected by imposition of the "Burlington Conditions," Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Abandonment, 257 L.C.C. 790.

The reason for the proposed abandonment is that there has been no traffic during 1974, 1975 and the first nine months of 1976. There is no prospect of obtaining the traffic necessary to justify continued operation of this portion of trackage. The proposed abandonment would not affect the movement of

products to and from this area. If abandonment is authorized this trackage will be reclassified as sidetrack. The Interstate Commerce Commission will rule upon this application without hearings unless protests are received which contain information indicating a need for such hearings. In accordance with the Commission's regulations (49 C.F.R. 1100.250) in Ex Parte No. 55 (Sub No. 4), Implementation National Environmental Policy Act, 1969, 340 L.C.C. 431 (1972), any protests may include a statement indicating the presence or absence of any effect of the requested Commission action on the quality of the human environment. If any such effect is alleged to be present, the statement shall include information relating to the relevant facts set forth in Ex Parte No. 55 (Sub No. 4), supra, Part (B) (1)-(5), 340 L.C.C. 431, 461.

Applicants state that the authority sought in the requested Commission action will have no significant effect on the quality of human environment.

Any protest referring to this notice (No. AB-37 Sub No. 6) shall be filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission, Washington, D.C. 20423, not later than December 1, 1976.
