NOTICE OF ORDER ESTABLISHING MINT DISEASE CONTROL AREA IN MORROW COUNTY

In accordance with ORS 561.530 (4) and 561.585, the following notice is hereby rendered. An order establishing a mint disease control area in Morrow County was entered February 15, 1977, and is effective March 1, 1977. This order provides the following: (a) only allows a change of ownership of propagation mint root stock within the control area if such stock is Oregon State University Certified II or better, or has been certified by the department; (b) limits importation of mint root stocks into the control area to Oregon State University Certified II or better root stocks; (c) requires mint growers to submit mint field maps indicating the location and certification of mint root stock; (d) requires mint growers to retain documentation of mint root stock sources and maintain maps of new plantings; and (e) provides for inspection of mint fields by the State Department of Agriculture if such are not eligible for Oregon State University certification. The order shall continue in effect until removed in accordance with ORS 570.415. Complete copies of the order are on file and can be obtained from the Morrow County Clerk, the Secretary

of State, or the Oregon State Department of Agriculture. Dated this 16th day of February, 1977.
