

Kinzua, Forest Service to swap

Kinzua Corporation has entered a formal land exchange offer with the U.S. Forest Service involving approximately 9,834.29 acres of timber land in the Umatilla National Forest. The land is located in Morrow and Wheeler counties, according to H.B. Rudolph, forest supervisor, Pendleton.

The proposed land exchange, known as the Kinzua No. 2 exchange, has been approved by the Washington office of the U.S. Forest Service, USDA.

Second legal notice of the proposed land exchange appears in this issue of the Gazette-Times. The application involves 45 sections, including parts of 42 sections and all of three sections in Morrow County. Parts of seven sections are proposed for exchange in Wheeler County.

Any person claiming the properties listed or having valid objections to the proposed exchange must file their claims or objections with the Regional Forester at Portland

within 30 days after the date of the first publication of the notice.

The proposed exchange is part of a working arrangement whereby scattered tracts held by the Forest Service are exchanged for tracts within the main holdings of Kinzua. The practice gives both interests better organized blocks of land to work with and better control over respective programs, and conservation practices.
