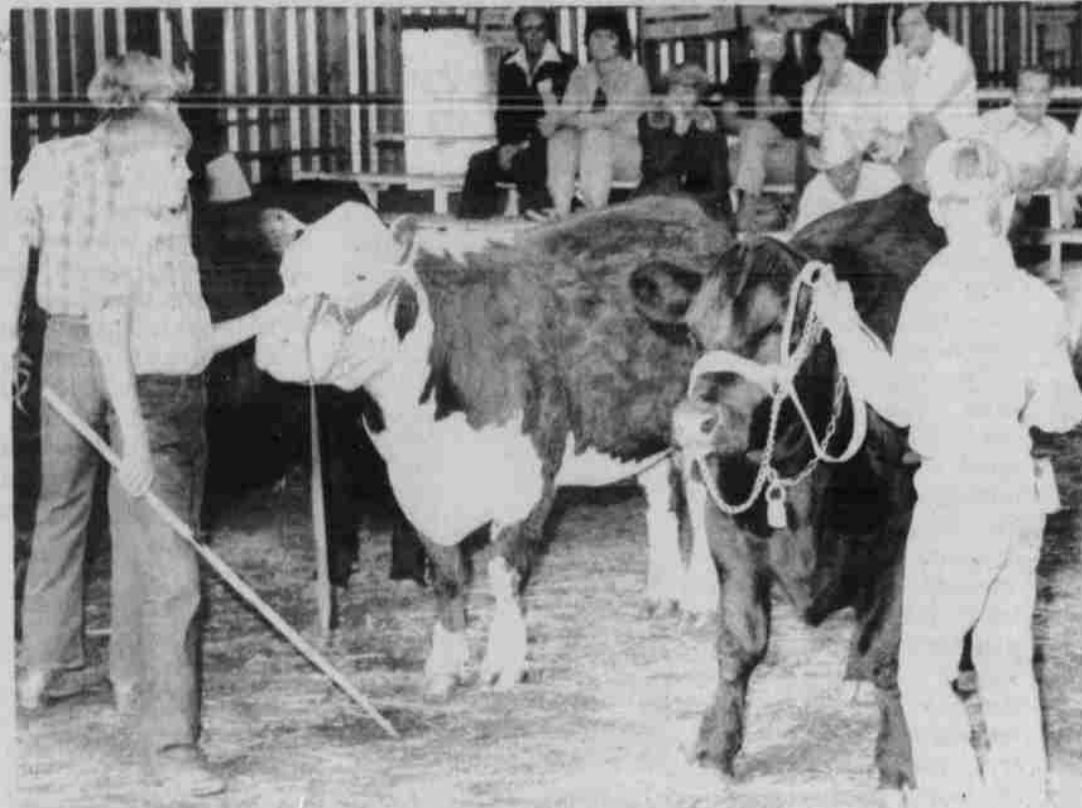


Livestock: some ride 'em, some show 'em

Water system improvements for the City of Irrigon under an E.P.A. grant are now complete. The \$116,000 grant added a 130,000 gallon storage area to the reservoir, extended a number of water lines and made interties between lines for more efficient water pressures and service. Also included in the improvements were the addition of a new well, pumps, pumphouse and several fire hydrants.

Several thousand dollars extra work above grant funds was done by the contractors, Sharpe and Prezler of Ken-

newick, as the city tried to eliminate bottlenecks in the

system in preparation for a Fire Insurance Rating Bureau

assessment of the system. The study is currently underway and a lower insurance rate for the city is anticipated.

The current improvements have assured better pressure patterns to every part of the city and greater fire fighting potential. The system is designed to handle water needs generated by future growth in the area.

A.C. Houghton School has been plagued with water problems for several years with pump failures. The school has decided to take advantage of city water this year and a meter was instal-

led the past week to service the facility. With the influx of students in the area it was considered a necessity.
