Local CF drive in progress

Citizens of Morrow County have been taking to the streets in mass this week as volunteer marchers for the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation's 1977 Breath of Life Campaign.

Marching door-to-door, the volunteers will be asking for contributions to help children who suffer from cystic fibrosis and other lung-damaging diseases.

The annual Breath of Life Campaign raises vital funds for research to find a cure for cystic fibrosis, and for care

and education program benefiting children suffering from CF and other lung-damaging diseases.

Lung diseases are second only to cancer in taking the precious lives of children and cystic fibrosis, which occurs once in every 1,600 live births in the United States, is the most serious of all children's lung diseases. A presently incurable disease, CF produces a thick, sticky mucus which clogs the lungs and

digestive system of its victims.

Almost half the money raised in the local Breath of Life Campaign will stay in Oregon to benefit children with CF and other lung diseases like severe asthma, chronic bronchitis and bronchiectasis.

The remaining funds collected in the state will be distributed through the national CF Foundation to help support research for a control or cure of cystic fibrosis.
