Here's something you should know about your fall and spring fertilizer applications.

The Oregon State Department of Agriculture requires that you hold a private applicators license by October 21, 1977.

You will be required to present this license when purchasing or using restricted chemicals such as Paraquat, Dinitro, Disyston and many others. The chemical 2-4D is also being considered as a restricted chemical in the future.

In a continuing effort to help you hold the line on costs, Morrow County Grain Growers and the County Extension Office, will co-sponsor a school and examination session October 11, at 7:30 p.m. at the Fairgrounds in Heppner.

If you have not obtained your private applicators license, we urge you to attend.
